Austyn Raine Cianciaruso

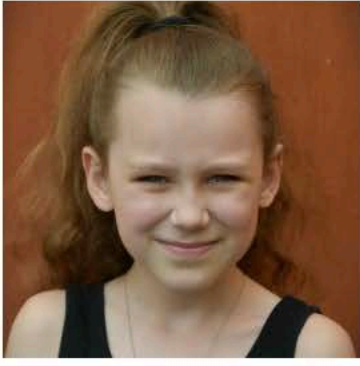

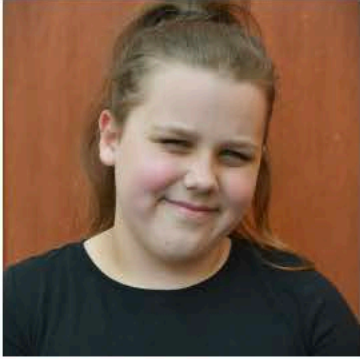

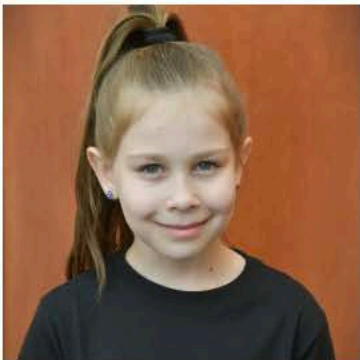

Mikayla Dashko

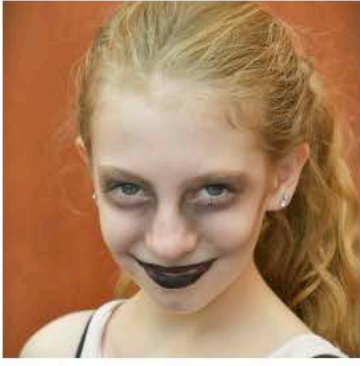

Melanie Grinblat

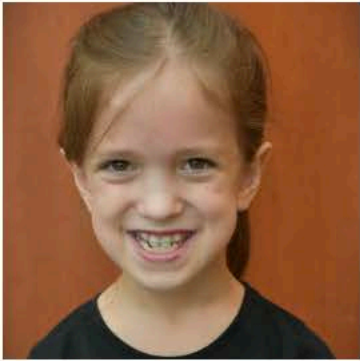

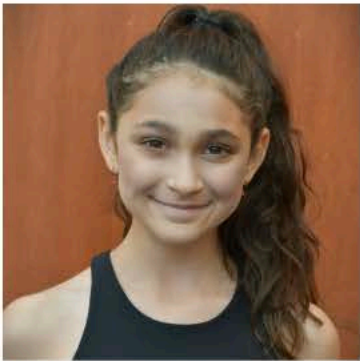
Adeline Kearns

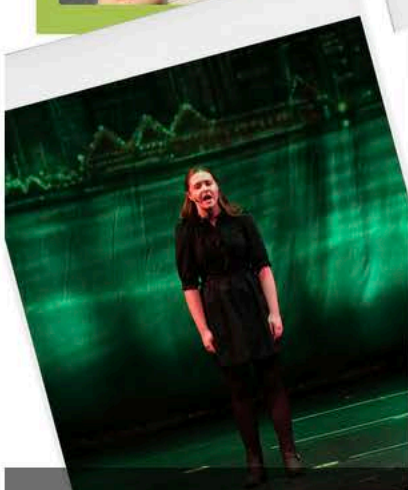

DIRECTOR'S NOTE

IT'S SHOWTIME!!! Thank you for attending Infinite Motion Performing Arts Academy's first annual spring musical, *Beetlejuice Jr.*!

What you are about to witness is the culmination of Ethos Theatre Company and the brand new Ensemble Workshop's training from the 2024-2025 season. Each member of this cast has taken the time to learn music, lines, blocking, and choreography for this zany show. Several members of the cast also got involved in prop construction and costume design. Students learned the structure of a musical, how to properly read and annotate their scripts and scores, how to track their show and navigate backstage traffic, including quick changes and scene transitions, and so much more that extends beyond the rehearsal space. Theatre teaches us how to feel comfortable enough in ourselves so we can embody a character! This is a skill that they can take with them for the rest of their lives, whether they choose to pursue theatre or not. Our rehearsal room modeled a professional one, giving students the full musical experience! Through this process, this cast came together as one; supporting and helping each other along the way. I am enamored by their dedication, commitment, and enthusiasm to bring this show to life... or death!

Personally, *Beetlejuice* is one of my favorite shows, and I am ecstatic that I got to direct and choreograph it. Masked with silly songs and quirky antics, the root of this story is about finding your meaning of home. As we follow Lydia on her journey, we learn alongside her that home is more often a feeling rather a physical location. When we lose that feeling, we feel lost, small, and invisible. At that crossroad, we have a decision to make: stay where we are, or make a change. Thankfully, Lydia chooses the latter, inspiring us to take our lives into our own hands.

I hope that at the end of this process, these young artists can confidently call the theatre and the community we have created a home to them.

To my Ethos kiddos - I am so incredibly proud of your growth this season! My goal this year was to bring this company together as a strong ensemble and you have done that on stage and off! From a quick pivot in the fall for Ghoul Times, to an entire NYC Workshop day, you have all excelled above and beyond in what was expected of you!
